

Tillamook June Dairy Parade Parade Participant Instructions

No entry fee is required.

Blurb -

The 2014 parade starts at 10:30 a.m. from the Tillamook County Fairgrounds. The Parade officially starts at 11:00 AM from Goodspeed Park. Line-up time at the marshaling areas will be 8:00 a.m. to permit the judging of entries before the parade starts, as well as during the parade.

You are cordially invited to participate, and your prompt return of the entry blank will assist in making this one of Oregon's finest parades. The parade route and line-up information will be mailed to all entrants the week prior to the parade. Each participant who wishes to be judged must submit a separate entry form.

ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED AT BOTH MARSHALING AREAS AND ON PARADE ROUTE.

"WE ENCOURAGE POLITICAL FLOATS IN GOOD TASTE WITH A POSITIVE STATEMENT. WE ALSO ENCOURAGE OUR SENATOR AND REPRESENTATIVE TO ENTER THE PARADE AS A PART OF OUR GREAT AMERICAN TRADITION. CANDIDATES MAY ENTER SO LONG AS THEY PROJECT A POSITIVE, UPBEAT IMAGE."

All parade entries must bear and display a parade number on both sides of float and entry.

****HANDOUTS:**

CANDY, GUM, WATER, OR MATERIALS OF ANY SORT, ARE PROHIBITED FROM BEING THROWN DURING ANY PART OF THE PARADE OR ALONG PARADE ROUTE BY ENTRANTS IN THE LINE OF MARCH. THIS IS A DECISION MADE BY OUR EVENT INSURANCE CARRIER. YOU ARE MORE THAN WELCOME TO HAND TREATS TO PARADE VIEWERS, PLEASE DO NOT THROW ITEMS.

Sufficient visibility must be provided for drivers of floats. ALL VEHICLES EXCEPT VINTAGE CARS AND PIG'N FORDS MUST BE DECORATED IN SOME MANNER. THIS INCLUDES ALL OTHER AUTOMOBILES AND TRUCKS. DRIVERS OF ALL LICENSED VEHICLES MUST HAVE THE APPROPRIATE DRIVERS LICENSES FOR THE VEHICLE ENTERED.

(All dignitaries need to furnish their own vehicles)

Any specialty unit with a motorized vehicle (floats) must present evidence of insurance for bodily injury and property damage liability with combined single limits of \$100,000, other vehicles must provide proof of private car/vehicle insurance.

So that floats and entrants in the parade may get full benefits to which they are entitled through radio and newspaper publicity, it is agreed that a full and complete description of the entry will be received no later than

Please list overall length and number of units in each entry. This helps us set up the marshaling areas.

Judges will take into consideration the appropriateness of dress or costume & musical participation of the participants and their effect in interpreting the theme.

EQUESTRIAN: No stallion will be allowed in the parade, and colts must be on a lead line. All entrants under 9 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times. All tack must be clean, in good repair and properly fitted. Horses must be kept under control at all times or will be asked to leave parade. (You need to furnish your own pooper-scooper) **POOF OF PERSONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE** THAT COVERS YOUR ANIMALS AWAY FROM YOUR PREMISES REQUIRED OF ALL EQUESTRIAN ENTRIES.

Please maintain forward motion at all times and allow 50 feet between each entry.

**Judging will begin with your arrival at the parade marshaling area. Manners and attitude will affect your final score. Judges decisions are final – Entries subject to re-classification by judges. Entrants will be notified at time of re-classification.
